



Academic Dean (CAO) of the MACC

The Mexican American Catholic College (MACC) in San Antonio, Texas, a leader in Hispanic Ministry since 1972, seeks an academic dean to oversee the educational formation programs of the College. MACC's mission is to educate and empower leaders for service in a culturally diverse Church and society. MACC students, clergy, seminarians, deacon candidates, religious, and laity can further their education for ministry in their native language (Spanish or English), while attaining bilingual proficiency. Over 130 students are enrolled in its degree-based programs and over 500 students register annually in the language and continuing education programs and workshops. The robust student population and innovative programs are poised to expand through online technologies and augmented partnerships with dioceses and religious communities. One of the principal academic partnerships is MACC's delivery of all the courses of the major for a B.A. in Pastoral Ministry which is awarded by University of the Incarnate Word, the largest Catholic university in Texas. As MACC's Chief Academic Officer, the dean is expected to collaborate closely with UIW, Assumption Seminary, and diocesan partners to ensure excellence in the curriculum, teaching, and administration of the educational formation programs. Candidates must hold an earned doctorate from an accredited institution (preferably in theology, ministry, or philosophy); possess an excellent record of teaching, and substantive administrative experience. The ideal candidate will also have good bilingual (Spanish/English) communication skills, experience in ministerial formation, and a working knowledge of accreditation standards and processes. The candidate must be a practicing Roman Catholic in good standing.
