MACC has need of adjuncts in a variety of MACC's curriculum and philosophy of teaching are inspired by Blessed John Henry Newman's Idea of a University, particularly the view that education is best understood as cultivation of the intellect and that each course in a curriculum should be aimed at helping the student to understand the integrated nature of knowledge. MACC faculty are committed to this philosophy and to partnering in the formation of the whole person.

MACC is an equal opportunity employer. Compensation is according to a schedule based on degree earned, number of credit hours of class taught, level of instruction and may be further negotiated for classes under 5 students. Adjuncts are needed for daytime and evening classes.

Preferred Academic and Professional Qualifications:

- Terminal degree (i.e. PhD, STD, ThD, etc.) required for graduate courses and preferred for undergraduate, however an earned M.A or M.S. in the discipline taught is acceptable for undergraduate courses
- Demonstrated excellence in teaching and commitment to partnering in student flourishing
- A mandatum from the Archbishop of San Antonio and signed oath of fidelity for theology related disciplines
- Faithful, practicing Catholic for theology and philosophy related disciplines; for other disciplines adjuncts may be non-Catholic but must be willing to actively support the Catholic identity and mission of MACC
- Faculty needed to teach in English and Spanish; bilingual faculty would be ideal
