



## RESPONSIBILITIES OF FULL-TIME INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Mexican American Catholic College is approved by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security to issue the SEVIS Form I-20 to non-immigrant full-time students. The approval was awarded after the School was visited, and demonstrated that regulations that apply to F-1 students will be followed. Student files will be maintained according to specific guidelines.

A student who is issued a SEVIS Form I-20 will agree to abide by the regulations set for non-immigrant full-time students. Students **MUST immediately** report to the Designated School Official (DSO) **any changes** in:

- **Name**
- **Current address in the U.S.**
- **Degree program**
- **Number of credit hours each semester**
- **Planning any trip out of the U.S.**
- **Transfer to another U.S. school**
- **Sponsorship**
- **Change of status to Religious Worker, U.S. permanent residency**

DSO approval is required for the following:

- Drop or withdraw from a course which makes the student less than full-time
- Employment in the U.S.

Students who do not inform the DSO risk being “out of status” and subject to deportation.

As a non-immigrant foreign student, I agree to abide by the U.S. Federal Laws. It is my responsibility to keep the Mexican American Catholic College Designated School Official (DSO) for International Students informed of any changes to the items listed above. I understand that I must be a full-time student every semester to remain in the U.S. in status as an F-1 student. I agree to attend any meeting required by the D.S.O.

**Immigration papers (I-20, Visa, Passport & I-94) should be in your possession at all times.**

I understand the information and accept the responsibility to meet above requirements.
